Trip Information Sheet



YouthWorks (<http://www.youthworks.com/>) is the organization we are planning this trip through. Their staff will be leading the mission trip on the ground and dealing with housing and food issues while we are there.



February 16 is the drop dead deadline where we have to declare and pay for all the spaces we are claiming. After that it's non-refundable. The cost per person is \$298. This covers room and board while we are in San Francisco. They do have vegetarian options in their meals.

We will be staying at Temple Baptist Church (<http://tbcfsf.org/>) and we will need to bring sleeping bags or air mattresses. We will be showering at the YMCA (<http://www.ymcasf.org/stonestown/>) which is nearby.

The whole week is programmed from Sunday evening when we arrive (4:30 to 6:00 pm) to Friday morning when we are done (9:00 am) both in terms of work and recreation. There is no option to go off on our own as a group or individuals.

We have to have at least one chaperone for every 7 youth according to their policy and we must have at least one male and one female chaperone. Our adult chaperones are Pastor Lawrence and Angela Hauger.

We need to provide our own transportation while we are there. We cannot rely on public transportation. This means we will probably need to rent a van for the week there. Just looking at Budget and Avis, we're probably talking around \$500-\$600 for a one week rental. There may be other options we could explore.

Air travel costs are variable. Right now the cost looks like it will be somewhere between \$350 and \$450 per person. We are looking into best options for planning this.
